# Grades 1-6 Start-Up:

Tuesday, September 3, 2024 – 8:55 – 10:55

When the morning bell rings, students will line up at their line up locations from last year and will be taken to their classrooms from last year. Please send your child with a snack as we will be having a recess break. **New students to the school will meet in the gym at 8:55.** 

## Students are dismissed at 10:55.

Wednesday, September 4, 2024 to Friday, September 6th – Full Days Begin – 8:55 – 2:50 Returning students will go back to their classroom from last year. New students will return to the classroom they were placed in on Tuesday. Please send your child with a recess snack and lunch as our **canteen will not be running during the first week.** Students will be moved to their new classrooms on Friday during the school day.

Monday, September 9th - All students go to their new classrooms that they were placed in on Friday.

Please note that there may have to be some small changes to our classes following these placements but we do our best to keep students in the classrooms they are placed in on Friday. Thank you for your understanding.

#### Communication:

Communication between home and school is vital to a successful school year. Teachers are always reachable by school email. All teacher emails are teacher first name initial, full last name, followed by @prn.bc.ca. For example, my email is <u>jlavoie@prn.bc.ca</u>. If your child's teacher uses Dojo or another platform to communicate, this information will be shared with you once classes have settled in.

#### School Lunches:

## Absences and Late Arrivals:

Staff, families and students should be checking regularly for symptoms of illness to make sure they do not come to school when sick. Students who become sick while at school must be picked up as soon as possible. Please make sure your contact information is up to date at the office.

Regular attendance is essential to a successful school year. We do understand that from time to time absences may occur. If your child plans to be away for a lengthy period of time, please connect with your child's teacher for ideas on what your child can be working on while they are away.

#### Field Trips:

Permission forms must be completed for all field trips off school property. Your child's teacher will send home a permission form prior to any field trips. **Verbal permission, texts, and emails will not be accepted.** 

• Field trip attendance is dependent on students following behaviour expectations and safety guidelines, as determined by their teacher and school administration. At times parents may be asked to attend with their child.

## **Cell Phone and other Internet Connected Device Policy:**

Alwin Holland expects a learning environment with limited distractions and the responsible use of digital technology. It recognizes the research that shows that frequent cellphone interruptions in the classroom, social media platforms with addictive algorithms and an increasing level of cyberbullying and online exploitation of young people, are having a negative impact on instruction, learning, and student mental health.

Definition: "Personal Internet-Connected Devices" include, but are not limited to, cell phones, tablet computers, smartwatches, and portable video game systems.

Guidelines/Principles:

- Students will have access to school/district-owned technology at an age-appropriate level that supports learning and the development of digital technology skills and digital citizenship.
- As outlined in an Individual Education Plan (IEP), Learning Support Plan (LSP), or health plan, schools will exempt specific students from restrictions on the use of





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personal internet-connected devices when they are needed for full inclusion in a specific learning activity.

- At the elementary school level, the use of and access to personal internet-connected devices will not be permitted at any time during the school day.
- The security and storage of personal internet-connected devices is the sole responsibility of the owner/user. The District assumes no responsibility for the safety, security, loss, repair or replacement of such devices.
